



Cleveland Yard Waste Site, located at 289 Whitetail Lane. The Yard Waste site is for Village residents only and operates seasonally from April 1 to November 30. This summary reviews the acceptable and non-acceptable material. ***Our Yard Waste Site is under surveillance.***

Acceptable items:

Brush, branches, and clean wood (Place these items in the area labeled Brush)

- **Brush and branches:** This includes smaller sticks and branches typically considered “brush”.
- **CLEAN wood:** Wood must be separated from other refuse and cannot be larger than 5 inches in diameter.

Yard and garden waste (Place these items in the area labeled Compost)

- **Yard waste:** Grass clippings, leaves, flowers, and weeds.
- **Garden waste:** Includes food items from a garden, such as fruits and vegetables.

Other materials (Place these items in the area labeled Compost)

- **Dirt and mulch:** Must be placed in the designated compost pile.
- **Sod:** Acceptable only if all the soil has been removed.
- **Sawdust:** Acceptable if it comes from untreated wood

Items not accepted

- **Large wood:** Large logs, stumps, and branches wider than 6 inches in diameter or more than 5 feet long.
- **Lumber:** No Treated, Painted, or Stained Wood
- **Wood with fasteners:** No Construction materials including nails, screws, and other fasteners.
- **Roots and sod:** Sod with soil still attached, shrubs with intact root balls, and roots are not accepted.
- **General waste:** Trash, ashes, plastic bags, concrete, bricks, animal waste, carcasses, electronics, and other garbage.

Citations will be issued to those failing to follow the rules of the Yard Waste Site under Chapter 3, Sec. 9-3-2 of the municipal code.
