

VILLAGE OF CLEVELAND NOTICE OF PUBLIC TEST

The Public Test of the optical scan tabulating equipment to be used at the Partisan Primary Election on August 11, 2026, will be conducted on Monday, August 3, 2026, at 10:00 am at the Cleveland Village Hall, 1150 W Washington Ave, Cleveland. This Public Test is open to the public.

The testing provides an additional way to ensure that voting machines are working properly, and that the election will be conducted accurately. By state law, a pre-election test of voting equipment occurs before every election and in every municipality across Wisconsin. In the public tests, voting machine programming is verified by feeding a set of pre-marked ballots into each machine and reviewing the results tape that is generated. An errorless count is required at the conclusion of the testing. According to Wis. Stat. 5.84(1), any anomalies identified in testing must be remedied before the equipment can be used in an election.
